We are writing on behalf of the unit owners, as the General Contractor engaged by New Haven Condominiums, in conjunction with Ameritech Property Management.

As of today, more than one hundred seventy (170) condominium units remain severely affected to varying degrees, requiring completion of mitigation and ultimately full reconstruction. Mitigation has been completed; however, building permits are still in process. Due to the scope of work and permitting timelines, our current projection for unit turnover and safe occupancy is June 5, 2026.

We respectfully request that FEMA extend temporary housing assistance until June 5, 2026, to ensure displaced unit owners remain supported throughout this recovery period.
